Pleasure Class

This 2-part class will measure each horse's willingness and ability to be a pleasure to handle on the ground and under saddle. Each entrant will do a simple in-hand showmanship pattern, and then all of the horses will come into the arena together and be judged at the walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope. The horses in this class should be well-broke, relaxed, quiet, soft, and cadenced at all gaits.

Cow Work Class

Participant will enter the arena, ride at a walk to the first cone, trot to the second cone; lope to the third cone and to the center of the arena. Rider will ask for a cow. The rider must pass the cow through the chalk circle. Rider has 2 minutes to complete. Points will be awarded based on ability to handle the cow. Class is limited to 10 participants.

Freestyle Class

This class can be anything you want that best displays your mustangs abilities. Contestants supply their own props and music if desired. Judging will be on creativity and horse's ability to perform task asked. Event time limit is 3 minutes. Music is encouraged. Class is limited to 10 participants.

Extreme Mustang Race

The majority of the obstacles that you will encounter in the EMR event are things you will routinely encounter while on a trail ride or daily work on a ranch. The course is modeled after the Extreme Cowboy Race. A score is given for each obstacle on the course. A score is also given for overall horsemanship and speed. Class is limited to 10 participants.
